## PUBLIC SERVICES & SPORT (LEVEL 2)

**THIS COURSE COMBINES THE THEORY OF PUBLIC SERVICES AND SPORT WITH PRACTICAL SKILLS, INCLUDING LEADERSHIP. IT IS IDEAL IF YOU WISH TO ENTER A PUBLIC SERVICE OR PROGRESS ONTO AN ASSOCIATED LEVEL THREE COURSE, THE COURSE WILL ENABLE YOU TO DEVELOP SKILLS REQUIRED IN A PUBLIC SERVICES AND/ OR A SPORTING ENVIRONMENT. THIS WILL INCLUDE PLANNING AND DELIVERING DIFFERENT PRACTICAL ACTIVITIES IN PARTICULAR, THOSE THAT ARE OUTDOORS AND ADVENTUROUS.**
