

Catch up Proposal 2021/22

We will deliver catch up to two groups of students, both of whom are eligible under the guidelines for the tuition fund n 2021/22.

- 1) Students on a level 1 or 2 programme who do not yet have a 4 in English and / or maths (137 students)
- 2) Students on a level 3 programme who have a 4 or 5 in English and / or maths and who live in one of the 27 most deprived postcode areas (320 students).

English and Maths Tuition

We will deliver 40 hours per week of both English and maths coaching using a small group intervention model similar to that used in schools. Students will work in groups of up to 5 with the tutor on specific skills identified as those most important for their progress. We will conduct diagnostic testing to establish the skills profile of each student, and group them accordingly for maximum benefit. Each student should receive one half hour session fortnightly with the coach. During the summer term, we may adjust the delivery model to focus on those students who are borderline as they approach terminal assessment.

Tuition in subjects other than English and Maths

Study Skills intervention run by two new full time skills coaches based in the ILC who can deliver study skills support to any level 3 student meeting the catch up criteria. This support will be delivered outside of lesson time, usually on a small group basis but sometimes one to one. Students will be nominated from the eligible student list by teachers for intervention.
